The Peter's Pence Collection unites us in solidarity to the Holy See and its works of charity to those in need. ##### Order:

The way in which Standing Order donations are made to the parish needs to change because of the introduction of a new computer system being used by the Diocese to make Gift Aid claims. The new system requires that donations are paid directly into the parish bank account rather than via a diocesan bank account.

The Diocese will shortly be writing to all current Standing Order Donors asking them to complete a new Standing Order (or, if preferred, a Direct Debit) made payable directly to the Parish and to cancel their existing Standing Orders paid to the Diocese. This change will benefit the parish as the donations will be received each month directly.

#### Settled Status for European Citizens:

If you want to be able to remain in the UK, make sure that you apply for the Settled Status on the government website before the 30th June. **Even if you have lived in the UK for many years, you still need to apply.** Make sure you keep a safe copy of the number of the passport or the identity document you use for applying as you will need it to prove your status. This is important if you have to renew your passport.
